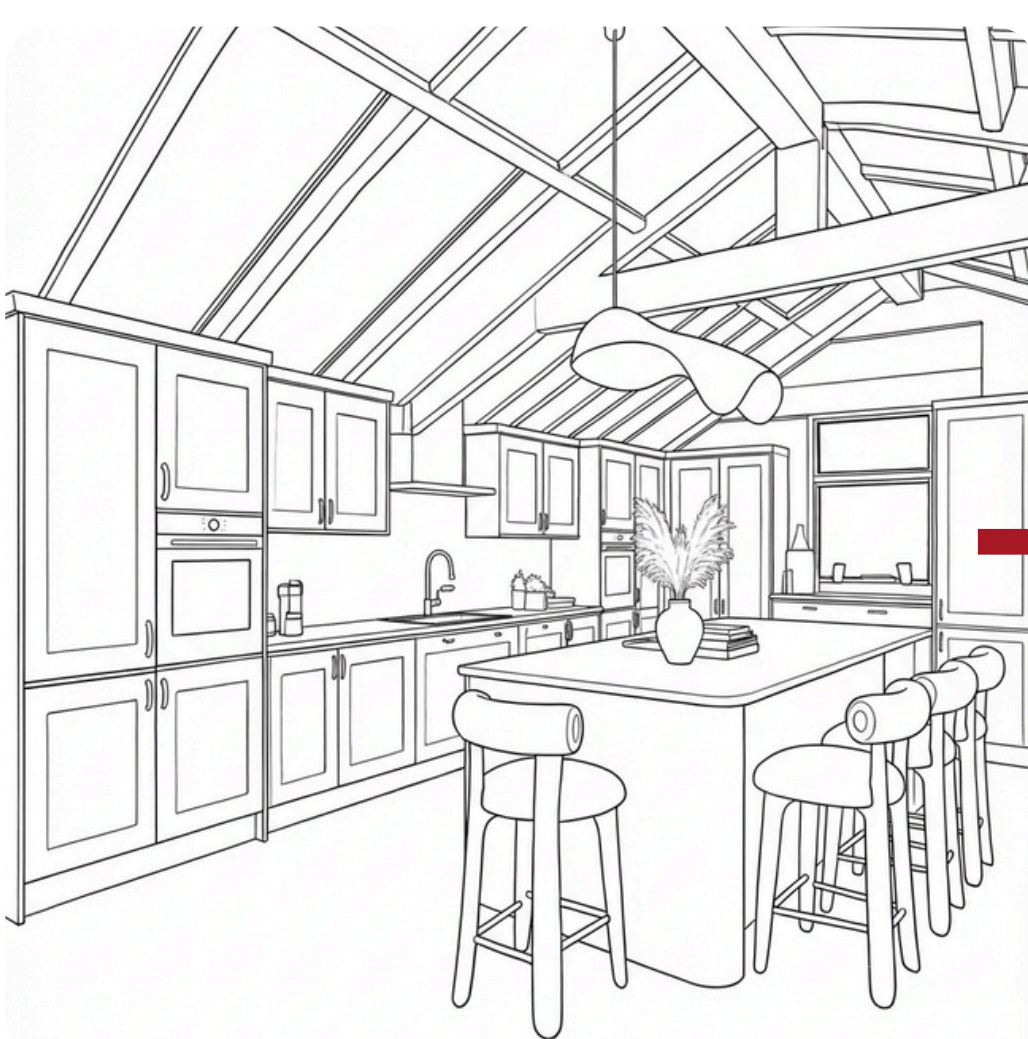

Tips & Tricks- Post-Render Editing:

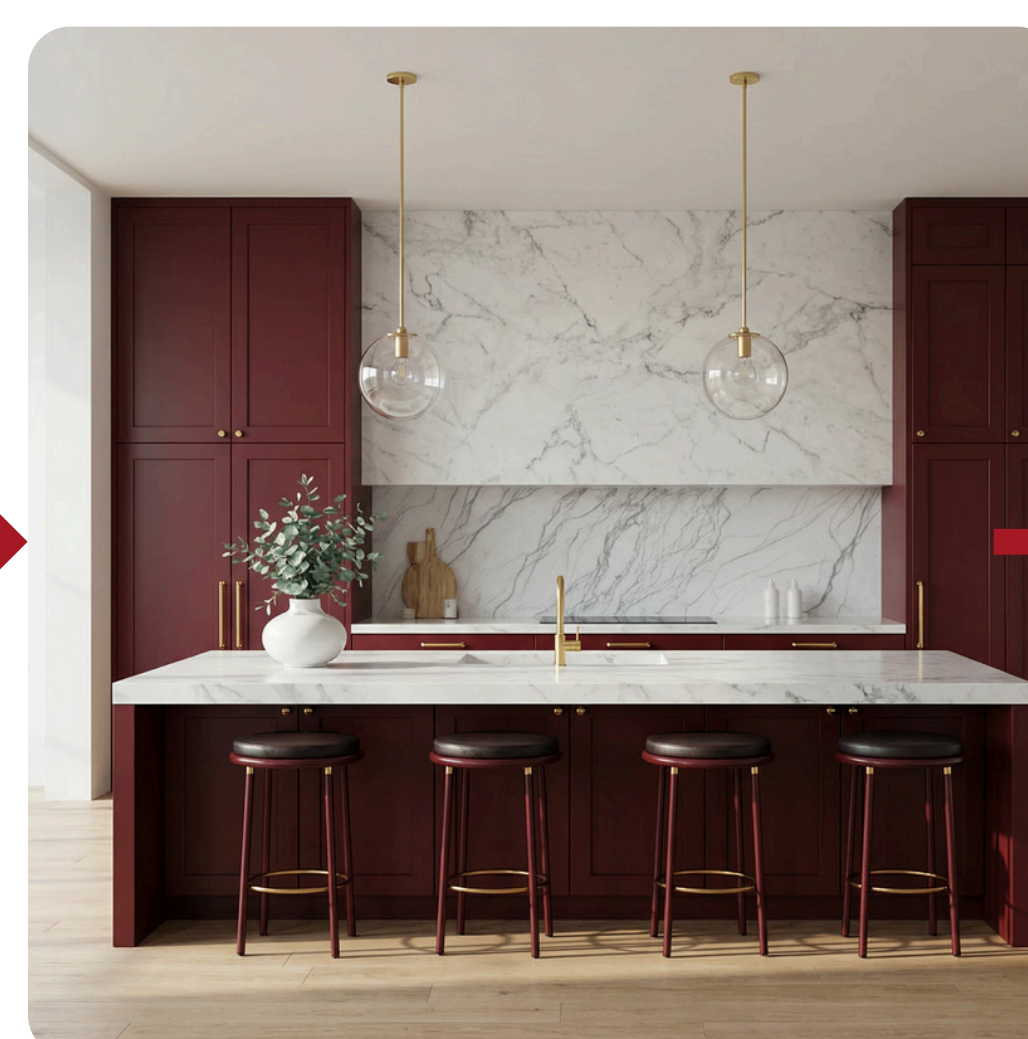
- Change colours & textures
- Add people & pets
- Turn lights on
- Add background
- Add spaces e.g. Living room
- Change lighting modes
- Decorate space
- Add furniture & fixtures

Recommendation: Creative Realism with Daylight. No ambient lighting or pre-render prompting required.

Tips & Tricks- Pre-Render Prompt:

If you are uploading a moodboard, you can specify where each material must be assigned to on your original layout image. Otherwise, allow our engine to take control and assign each material to the most logical location.

Recommendation: Specify where you would like the lights to appear and if you want any form of natural daylight. For e.g. Allow sun to beam into room, turn on pendant lights, warm ambient spot lights under wall units.

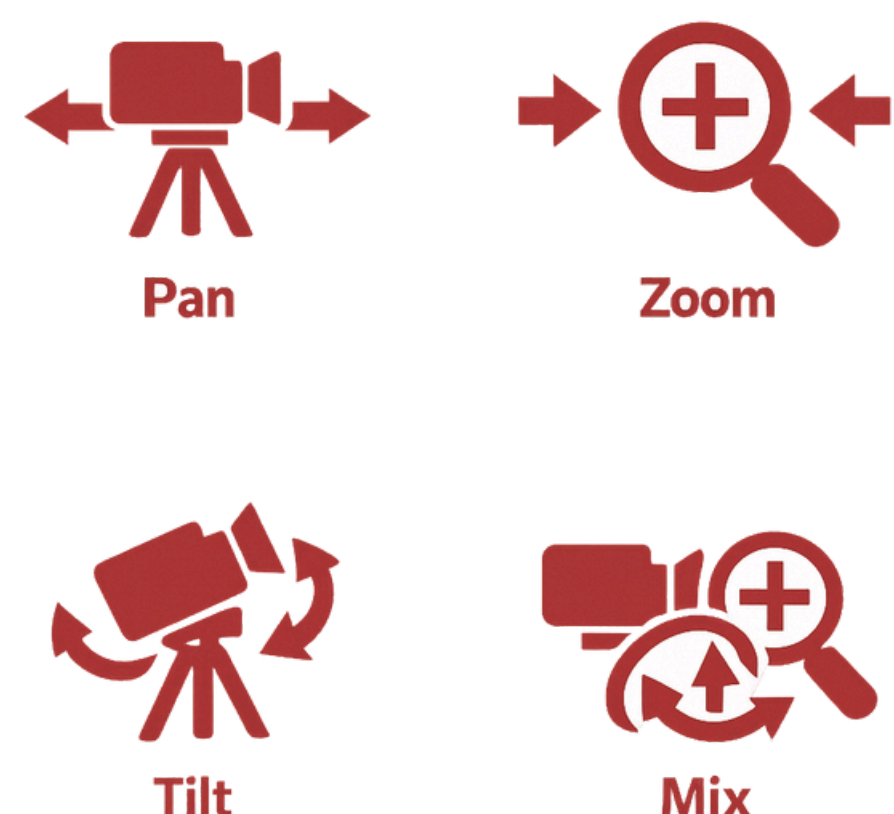


Editing Tool allows you to add specific:

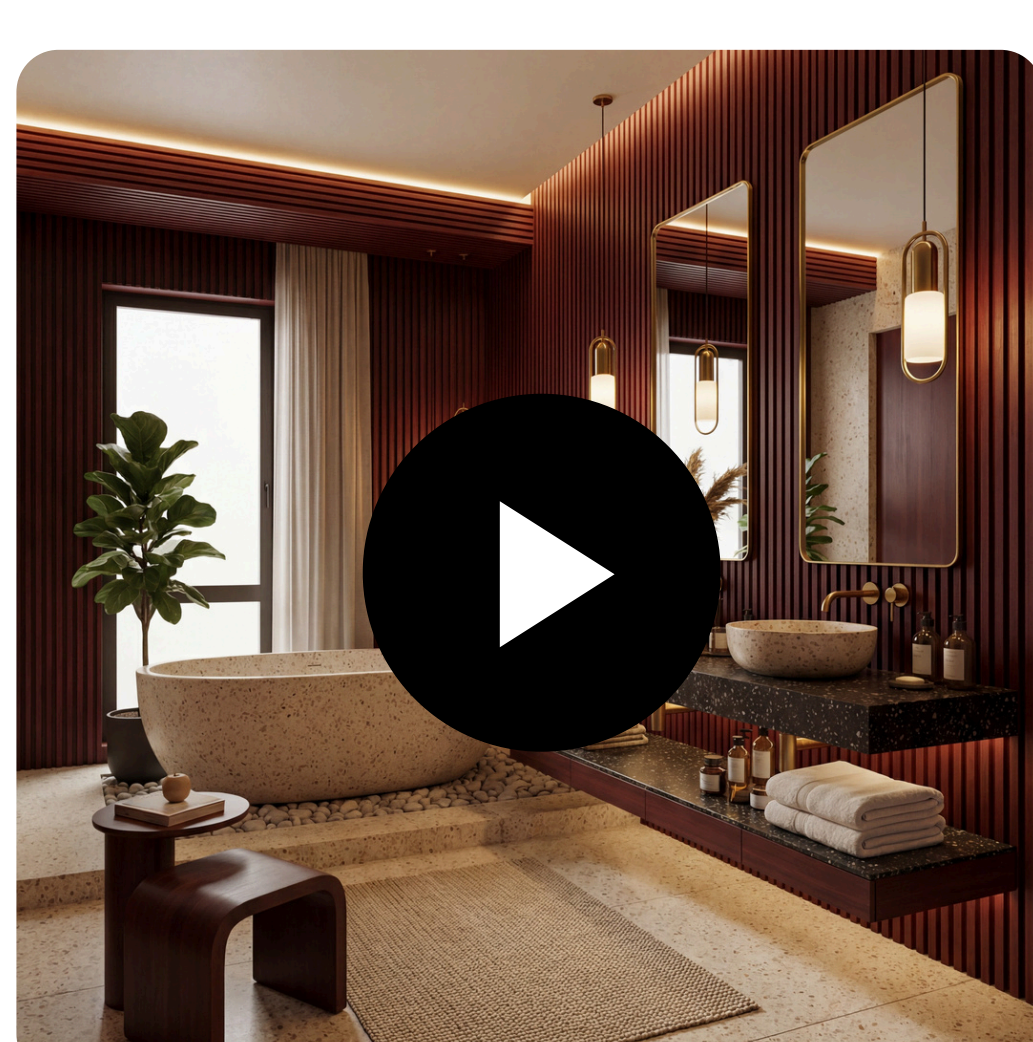

Tips & Tricks:

Try to add your angled images in logical order for best results.

You can also use this feature to transition from different lighting scenes. For example, from day time, to sunset, to nighttime, lights on or lights off.

You can add walking/moving elements if your original photorealistic image has people or pets for e.g.

Upload photorealistic renders in different angles

1 Rendering - Upload Your Base Images

You can upload **up to 6 images at once**.

Our render engine produces the **best results** when rendering cartoon style renders. Avoid rendering natively on your existing CAD/3D design software and then re-rendering on the KBB Render app.

For best results, your un-rendered image should:

- Be clear and not blurry
- Avoid heavy shadows or overexposure
- Show visible windows if using Night-time and Sunset mode
- Try to not use day time unless you have a window or external opening when using the render engine Precise Precision
- Keep line drawings clean and uncluttered
- Set your camera angle in an artistic manner keeping your visual field view straight. Do not face down at your scene, not face up.

Clean structure = cleaner output.



Important Rendering note

If you have a specific finish on a surface (for example flooring, glossy worktop, grey mirror splashback, silk bedding) make sure you add this to your Design Description under Advanced Settings. Keep your descriptions short and separated by commas. **DO NOT use this section to edit your scene, this is BEST done AFTER the render is complete.**

2 Choose Your Lighting Mode- Optional

You can select:

None (neutral result)	Night
Day	Sunset

And refine using lighting options (Ambient)

Warm	Cold
------	------

Cold and warm lighting allows our engine to creatively place LED lighting where it believes it can display a dramatic artificial lighting effect. Lighting changes perception dramatically, so don't be scared to explore different options.



Important Lighting Note

Night-time and Sunset Mode works best when windows are clearly visible in the original image. Why?

Because, for e.g., sunset mode relies on a specific type of lighting with visible HDR settings, designed to enter the space for that dramatic look.

If no window or opening is visible, the AI may interpret the scene differently or introduce unrealistic elements like forcing new window placements.

For best results:

- ✓ Ensure windows are visible when using Sunset + Night-time modes ✓ Use Day mode for clean presentation ✓ Use Night mode for controlled artificial lighting scenes

Lighting should make logical sense within the space.

Little tip: we recommend batch rendering similar types of images together.

For example all your different angle images that have windows, for sunset mode and daytime mode.

3 Generate High-Resolution Output

Choose your output quality:

4K

8K

Use 4K when preparing

Client presentations

Social media content

Emailing purposes

4K resolution is always recommended

Use 8K when preparing

Website visuals

Showroom displays

Marketing materials

Do not upscale to 8K if the design has been edited multiple times as it can cause distortions.

High resolution increases perceived value.



8K Download Note

We believe most designers will only ever need 4k and recommend this for your everyday workflow. In the event where you would like your generated image upscaled to 8k, please observe the results thoroughly.

8K has the ability to create very sharp images that you may lose natural imperfect details that make your render look more realistic. 8K may also distort visible writing in your rendered scene.

Be mindful of this. Finally, 8k upscaling takes time so ensure you do not exit the page until you receive your download.

4 Edit & Refine

You can edit generated images to:

Change wall colours	Adjust materials
Modify finishes	Refine specific elements

Editing is encouraged to be done AFTER the render has been produced. Do NOT use the first prompt box to edit your design heavily. Our current tools allow editing via words. Soon you will be able to upload specific finishes, colours, fixtures and furnitures.

This means you don't need to restart the process.

Advice: We highly recommend you make as many changes as you need **combined into one prompt.**

Prompting doesn't need to be extremely detailed, just describe your change in conversational manner. The shorter, the better.

Separate your edits with commas. Editing one image multiple times will lower resolution. We aim to find a solution to this soon. Until then, we recommend completing all your edits in one prompt box to maximise resolution output and save your credits.

Example prompt:

Change the existing wood flooring to large concrete tiles, change warm lighting to cold ambient lighting, add LED strip light under kitchen plinths, change sofa to velvet, add modern round rug in front of sofa, allow natural sunlight to enter the room from the left etc.

Small adjustments = faster client approvals.

Design. Visualised. Perfected.

5 Inspiration Transfer (Advanced Feature)

This is one of the most powerful features of KBB Render.

Option A – Line Drawing to Render

Upload:

- A clean architectural line drawing (black & white). The purpose of this is to retain your existing proposed layout clearly.

Little secret: you can still upload your normal cartoon style coloured render, however line drawings achieve the best results.

Then upload:

- An inspirational image (your own or from our library)

The system transfers the mood, style and material direction into a realistic render. The fusion is done in the most logical manner. You can make post-edit adjustments if needed.

Use this for:

- Early concept presentations
- Turning sketches into client-ready visuals
- Visualising ideas quickly before modelling fully

Option B – Mood Board to Render

Upload:

- Your mood board (you can take a photo directly from the app when using the mobile app) or upload an image

Or use:

- One of our extravagant pre-sets

The platform transforms it into a cohesive, realistic interior visual fusing your existing layout with a whole new scheme just through a single click.

This is ideal when:

- A client is undecided
- You need to test style directions
- You want to present lifestyle-driven concepts

When to Use Each Feature

Use Standard Rendering: When you already have a 3D model or rough render that needs upgrading.

Use Inspiration Transfer: When working from early-stage sketches or concept drawings. Or when clients keep changing their minds with colour schemes. Or use this if you need design direction or inspiration.

Use Mood Board Transfer: For exploration purposes and to give you inspiration for how to set your final design.

Use Editing: When the client requests quick colour or finish changes. Select the right feature based on the stage of your project.

This is only the beginning. We plan to implement a render to video generation mode, render to moodboard, one-click decoration and many more. Visit the features and update (education hub icon) section on our website for live updates on upcoming developments.

KBB Render is powered by advanced AI technology.

It delivers highly realistic, professional visuals, but it is not a technical CAD or construction software.

The engine cannot see your hidden settings within your existing software. What our engine sees, is exactly what is rendered.

Outputs are visually accurate, however:

- Minor details may vary
- Small elements can shift
- Dimensions are visually interpreted, not technically measured

Always review visuals before using them for technical production or manufacturing.

KBB Render is a visualisation and sales tool, not a technical plan generator.

Avoid These Common Mistakes

- Uploading very dark images and expecting bright results
- Using Sunset mode without visible windows
- Uploading distorted perspectives
- Using cluttered line drawings and cartoon renders
- Expecting engineering-level technical precision

The better the base logic, the better the output.

How to Use KBB Render to Win More Projects

The strongest users don't just "generate images."

They use KBB Render strategically. KBB Render is an advanced design tool. No need for photoshop. All edits can be done on our platform.

Professional workflow example:

- Initial Concepts: Gives designers direction on how to set out colour variations
- Generate 2–3 variations during client meetings
- Show colour or finish upgrades visually
- Use Sunset and night-time mode for emotional impact
- Send updated visuals immediately after consultation for quicker decisions

Speed builds confidence. Confidence closes deals.
